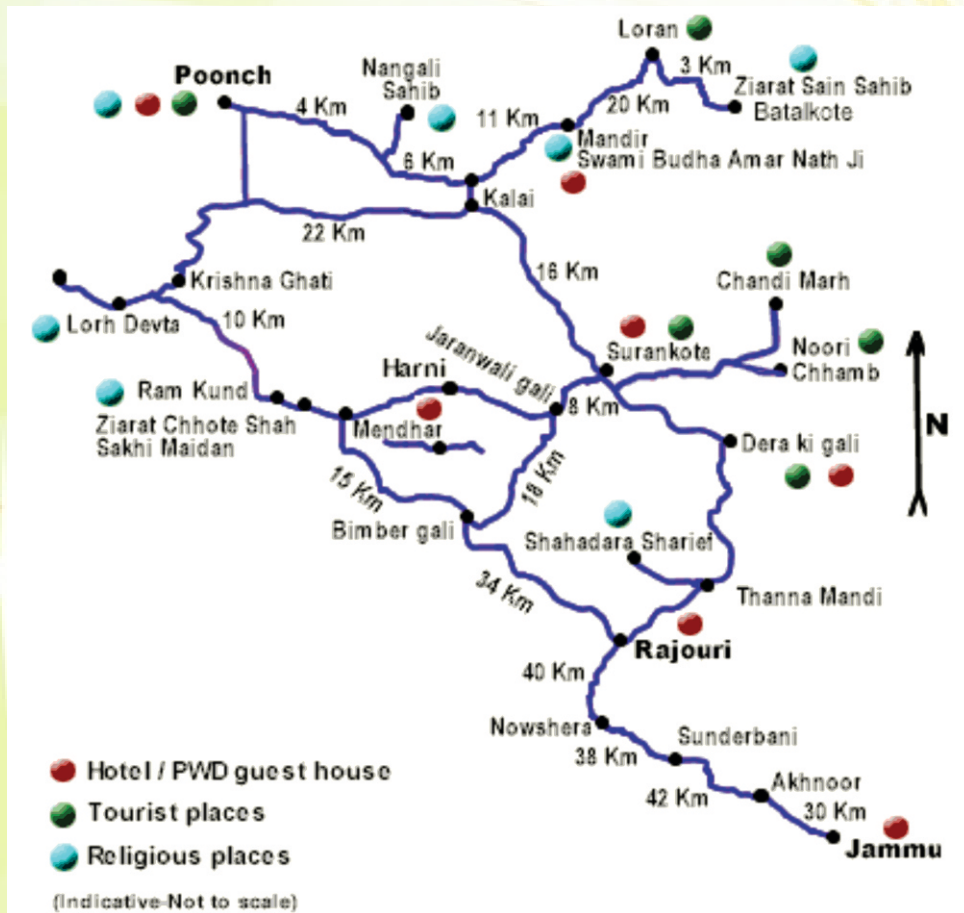




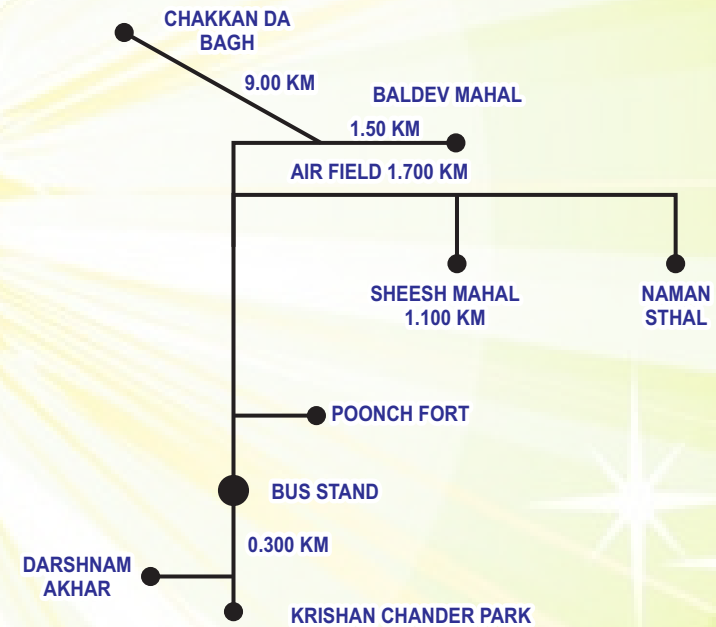
LOC Trade Centre Chackan-Da-Bagh

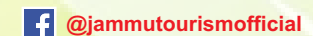

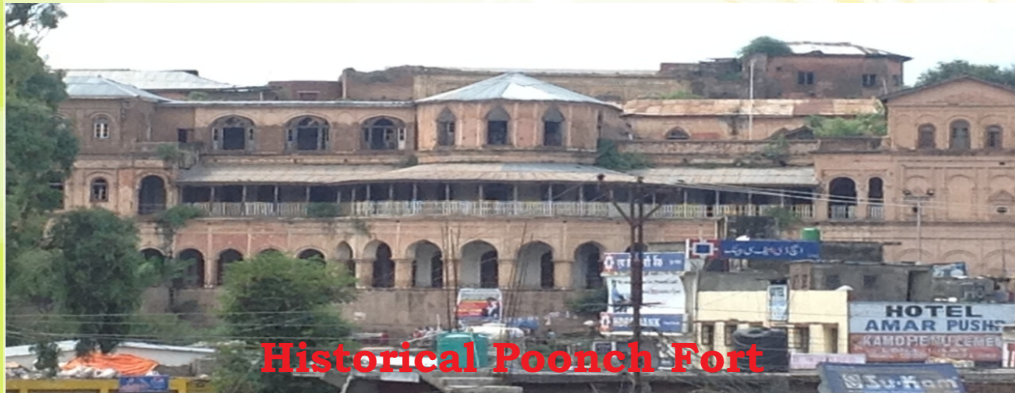

Historical Poonch Fort

- It is a composite architectural design & rich heritage building.
- Constructed during Muslim Rule (1713-1787AD), Sikh Rule (1819-1846AD) and Dogra Rule (1846-1947AD).



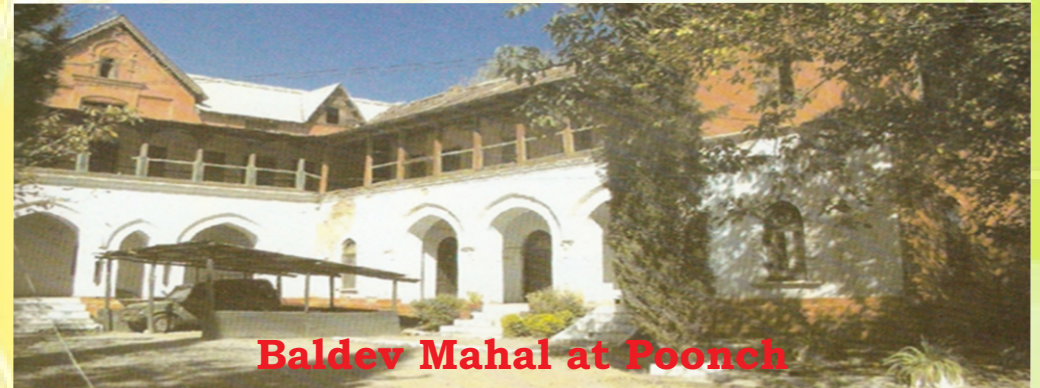
Sheesh Mahal

It was constructed for Rani Attlia, wife of Late Raja Sukhdev Singh built in (1927-1940).



Moti Mahal at Poonch
